Include current athlete CFSA #'s, your coach's name and contact email info on the registration form. Please complete a Bio Sheet for each athlete and have it ready for submission when you register and pick up your bibs at the lower level Conference Room in Castle Mountain Day Lodge.

## **ENTRY FEES**

Entry fees will be \$75 base fee plus \$25 for each event. Both events total is \$125.

This is payable at registration on March 1 by cheque made out to AFSA or by credit card. Credit card payments will have an additional 3% charge.

## **LIFT TICKETS**

Will be purchased from Castle Mountain Resort Guest Services. The daily discount rate for competitors on official training and competition days is \$40 for juniors aged 13 – 17 years, and \$52 for adults 18 and over. Prices do not include GST. There is one complimentary ticket per team for a coach. If the coach has a Can West Ski Areas pass, the complimentary ticket they get with the CWSAA pass counts as the team complimentary ticket. Valid ID will be required.

## **LIABILITY**

All athletes, officials, organizers and other members of the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, the Alberta Freestyle Skiing Association, Sponsors and the Castle Mountain Resort shall not be responsible for any issue with the organisation or staging of the event. This group of persons **MUST** be registered as current CFSA members with the appropriate license.

## ACCOMMODATION/HOTEL INFORMATION

There are on-hill options, nearby rentals, and hotels in Pincher Creek which is about 40 minutes away.

A block of rooms for March 1-4 has been reserved at the **Ramada Inn** in Pincher Creek 1.403.627-3777. These rooms will all be released on **February 27**. Please request your room under the "Freestyle Can Series" block. Standard room price is \$142.49 + tax for 2 queens and a pullout couch.

Another block of rooms is available at the **Super 8** Motel in Pincher Creek 1.403.627-5671. Request the "Freestyle Ski Canadian Series" block to get the rate of \$112.50 + tax for a room with 2 queen beds. **Reserve before FEB 25**.

## TRAVEL TO CASTLE MOUNTAIN RESORT

Please be aware that radar is often set up in Beaver Mines (the last little town before Castle Mountain) so watch for the 50 km speed limit so your trip isn't marred by a ticket coming or going.
